Fall Sermon Series: Based upon the book of 1 John, the “Because you Know,” series will equip you to align your beliefs and behavior. John’s epistles were likely penned in Ephesus in 85-90 AD just as Gnosticism was gaining a foothold within the culture of the Middle East. The answers John provides to the Church are as relevant today as in the first century. First, Christ is our Advocate and the Gospel is the only way to life. Secondly, obedience is how we demonstrate our love for Christ. John declares this by contrasting lightness with darkness, truth to falsehood, and righteousness to sin. Third, John exhorts the Church to practice sound doctrine and to root out false teachings. And finally, John instructs the Church to love God rather than the world. Plan now to attend Nowthen each Sunday and invite a friend or neighbor to hear these important teachings!




