

This edition of the NAC eNews will focus on Christmas, including a preview of the many events occurring at Nowthen in December. Please take note of the Elder's benevolent "give the gift of Christmas to a family" opportunity - below. We will begin with the Christmas sermon series and Christmas Eve service times:



<u>Christmas Services 2017</u>: Beginning December 10th we will be looking topically at the hope God's People in the Old Testament were waiting for, leading up to Christmas Eve where we will celebrate that Hope Has Come. Join us for these messages this holiday season as we remember where our hope is found. This year, Christmas Eve happens to fall on a Sunday. There will be services 8:30am, 11:00am, and at 3:00pm. All three services will be similar with the same message. The 8:30am service will be in the sanctuary while the 11:00am and 3:00pm services will be held in the lower worship center.

Jesus was born in Bethlehem in approximately 2 BC. Bethlehem is located five miles south of Jerusalem and in 2 BC it was a tiny town of less than 1000 people. Yet 700 years prior to His birth, God told the prophet Micah (Micah 5:2) that the Messiah would be born in Bethlehem. Perhaps more striking, the prophet Isaiah (Isaiah 7:14) foretold the virgin birth of Jesus. In fact, the Old Testament records hundreds of prophecies concerning Immanuel, God with Us! Invite a friend and learn more about why we know that "**Hope Has Come**."



This year marks the 500<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Luther's posting of his 95 theses on the door of the Catholic Church in Germany, sparking the reformation and the Protestant movement.
